Next generation tree breeding

Scope of the meeting

The meeting will cover future challenges in tree breeding, such as novel breeding strategies, climate change, breeding for disease resistance, cooperation and use of common breeding material. During the meeting we will discuss and treat:

- Long term breeding in the Nordic countries in relation to climatic change
- Supportive research related to long term breeding
- Seed and plant supply from breeding (short term activities)
- Supportive research related to short term activities

Call for contribution

The meeting includes invited and voluntary presentations. Participants who intend to make an oral presentation are requested to submit an abstract for selection and allocation to meeting session. Presentations should be registered before **12 August**, and abstracts should be sent before **23 August**. The abstract should include the title, name and affiliation of presenter and an abstract in no more than 250 words. 20 minutes, including discussion, will be allocated for the voluntary presentations.
